Minutes:

Minutes of March 2005 Board Meeting approved; Kathy Arnold motioned and Jim Vargo seconded. Motion approved.

Discussion: Tom Lebens went over briefly having voting board members present at the meetings and the requirements for quorum.

Special Guests:

Chris Hansen representing Arroyo Grande Cemetery District was present along with Dave Myers and Mike Stroub of the Central Coast Condors to discuss and apprise us of a committee possibly being formed to lease 20 acres from the Cemetery District off El Campo Road and Sevada to possibly put a soccer field. They are looking at a 20-25 year lease on the property. We have 45 days to make a proposal before the cemetery district acts. There has been interest from another group to use it for agriculture however surrounding neighbors and residents do not want the land to be utilized for that purpose due to the pesticides. \$10, 000.00 per year for revenue is what the district is proposing. It is County owned property and the board will be putting together a committee and holding a meeting on Tuesday, May 3rd to get a plan in order. The meeting will be held at Cal West Property Management.

Treasurers & Auditors Report: Marlin Peterson; No report.

Regional Assessment Program Update:

Tom passed out the assessment handout for 2004. 2005 should be the same with minimal changes. We need to complete Category A items to get platinum again this year. Need to check safety issues. The Regional Budget is online and guidelines have been submitted. Category B; everything is in place however need to look at safety in this one as well. It was discussed we may need to help a sister region such as Nipomo. Coaching is looking very strong. We can miss three in this area but have most all of it. Refereeing: Pretty sure were going make it. We can miss three and right now were missing four. Need upgrades.

Coach Administrators Report: Tom Whalen: Had a great time at section meeting. Need is notifying all parents for U14 having to attend three days training in Santa Ynez.

100% trained in safe haven. When coaches have completed training they will receive a jacket. Overnighter training at The Dunn School in Santa Ynez on Saturday, August 12, 13, 14th.
