2010 Mail-In Soccer Player Registration

Mail-In Registration is from May 2-29 only.

After May 29, you must sign-up on the waiting list at locations listed below.

Please carefully review and follow ALL of the instructions for registration.

1. Fill out registration forms on-line at www.eayso.com
2. You will need to print and sign TWO copies of your player registration form.
3. You will need to provide a COPY of your players BIRTH CERTIFICATE.
4. Player fees are \$100 per player

Players must have been born by July 31, 2006 in order to be eligible to play

Mail player registration forms and birth certificate, along with your player fees to AYSO Region 83, PO Box 1166, Arroyo Grande, CA 93421. **Make Checks payable to AYSO.**

Players will not be registered until their player registration forms have been submitted to the registrar, player fees have been paid, and player age verified. (ALL mail-in forms must include payment and a copy of player's birth certificate)

Paper forms for those who do not have access to a computer and the waiting lists will be located at the following locations:

- Soccer Mart, 622 East Grand Avenue, Arroyo Grande
- Arroyo Grande Parks and Recreation, 1221 Ash Street (in Elm Street Park)

Registration date is determined by postmark. **Registration must be postmarked and complete by May 29, 2010 or players will be placed on a waiting list.**

After May 29, 2010, players may sign up on a waiting list and will be accommodated as resources permit. Waiting lists will be at the locations mentioned above.

NOTE: Registration does not guarantee placement of a player on a team. The number of teams we are able to field is determined largely by the number of fields we have available to us, and the number of volunteer coaches and referees participating. By volunteering to coach or referee, and participating in coach or referee training, parents can help to assure that all players who register are able to play. Players not placed on a team will be placed onto a waiting list, and can often be accommodated before the season starts; any players not placed on a team will receive a refund.
