

## **2010 FIVE CITIES CENTRAL COAST CLASSIC AYSO INVITATIONAL**

**WHEN:** January 15<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, and 17<sup>th</sup>

**WHERE:** Arroyo Grande, CA

**DIVISIONS:** Boys and Girls: Under 10: (August 1999 thru 7/31/01) 7x7 format  
Under 12: (August 1997 thru 7/31/99) 9x9 format  
Under 14: (August 1995 thru 7/31/97) 11x11

The effective date of age determination shall be the player's age as of July 31st of 2009.

This is an AYSO Invitational tournament. **A qualified referee team of no less than three referees must accompany any team accepted into the tournament. Each referee will be required to officiate 3 games. Tournament applications will not be accepted unless Team referees are provided. Referees are required to have at least one year experience and should be someone that you would like to see on your game! Referees must wear proper referee attire. A referee coordinator contact must be provided for the team.**

**APPLICATION FEE** The cost is U10 \$475, U12/U14 \$500 per team. All teams have a \$250 referee deposit. To be paid with one regional check. The referee deposit will be refunded to all teams completing their referee assignments. The refund will be available within 14 days after the tournament. No partial referee refund will be given to teams only completing part of their assignments. Applications will be processed at the sole discretion of the hosting region. Make checks (Region checks only) payable to **Five Cities AYSO Tournament** and enclose with application form and referee team form. AYSO Region 83 is a non-profit organization and the money earned from this tournament will go first to support our post-season program as it is run separately from our league season program. A portion of the money is left in our post season account as seed money for the next year. Any money left over will then go back into our league season account.

**REFUNDS:** Full refunds will be issued to teams that withdraw prior to 30 days before the tournament. Teams that withdraw less than 30 days before the tournament will receive a full refund if a replacement team can be found. Regardless of the reason, in the event a tournament is completely canceled, a full refund of all the team monies will be given to each team that entered.

**RULES:** A full set of rules can be found on the tournament website.

**MATCH PLAY:** Each team will be guaranteed a minimum of three games. U10 teams will play 7 v 7. Matches will be 48 minutes. U12 teams will play 9 v 9 and their matches will be 50 minutes. U14 teams will play 11 v 11 and their matches will be 60 minutes. Preliminary match play will take place Friday night, all day Saturday and

Sunday morning. Sunday afternoon will be reserved for Consolation and Championship match play and awards.

**AWARDS:** Individual medals/trophies for first through fourth place teams will be awarded in all divisions with at least six (6) participating teams. A maximum of 15 medals per U14 team will be awarded, 13 medals per U12 team and 10 medals for U10. Pins will be awarded to all participants.

**MEDICAL EMERGENCIES:** Field Marshals will be assigned to each location where games are played. All Medical Emergencies are to be reported immediately to the Field Marshal, who shall immediately assure that on-site medical personnel have been alerted and have responded. The Field Marshall shall report all Medical Emergencies to the Tournament Director as soon as practicable.

**APPLICATION DEADLINE:** Application deadline is January 1, 2010 or whenever the tournament is full. Notification of your team's acceptance into the tournament, once receipt of all documentation and teams deposits, will be e-mailed to the coach contact or your regional commissioner within 48 hours of deadline. We will have hotel information along with other information available on our website which is 5cities-AYSO.com. Any team that we are unable to accommodate in the tournament due to space limitations will be placed on a waiting list for possible cancellations. The tournament information packet that includes maps, tournament rules and schedules will be available when you check in.
